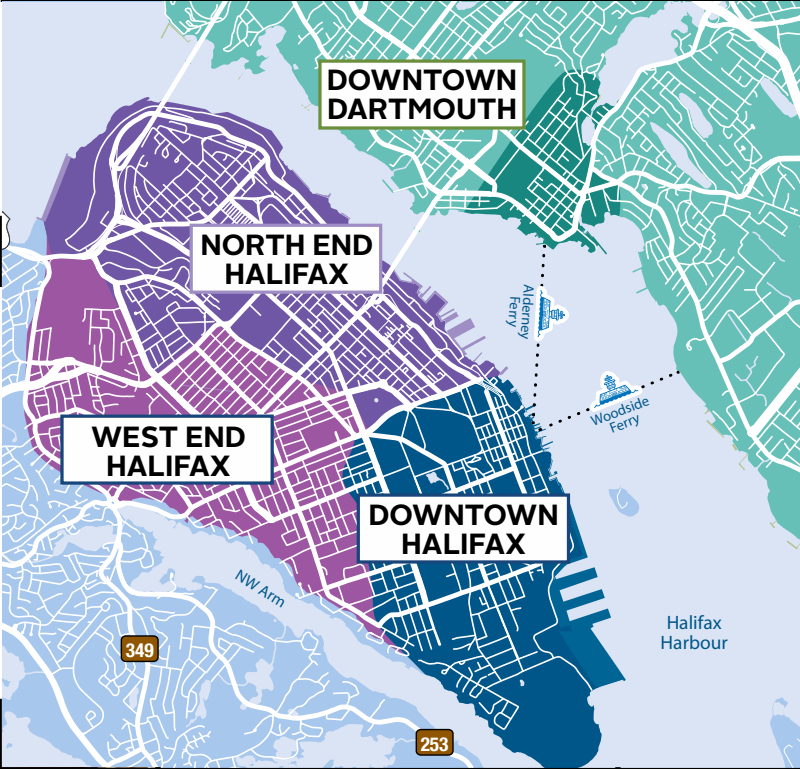
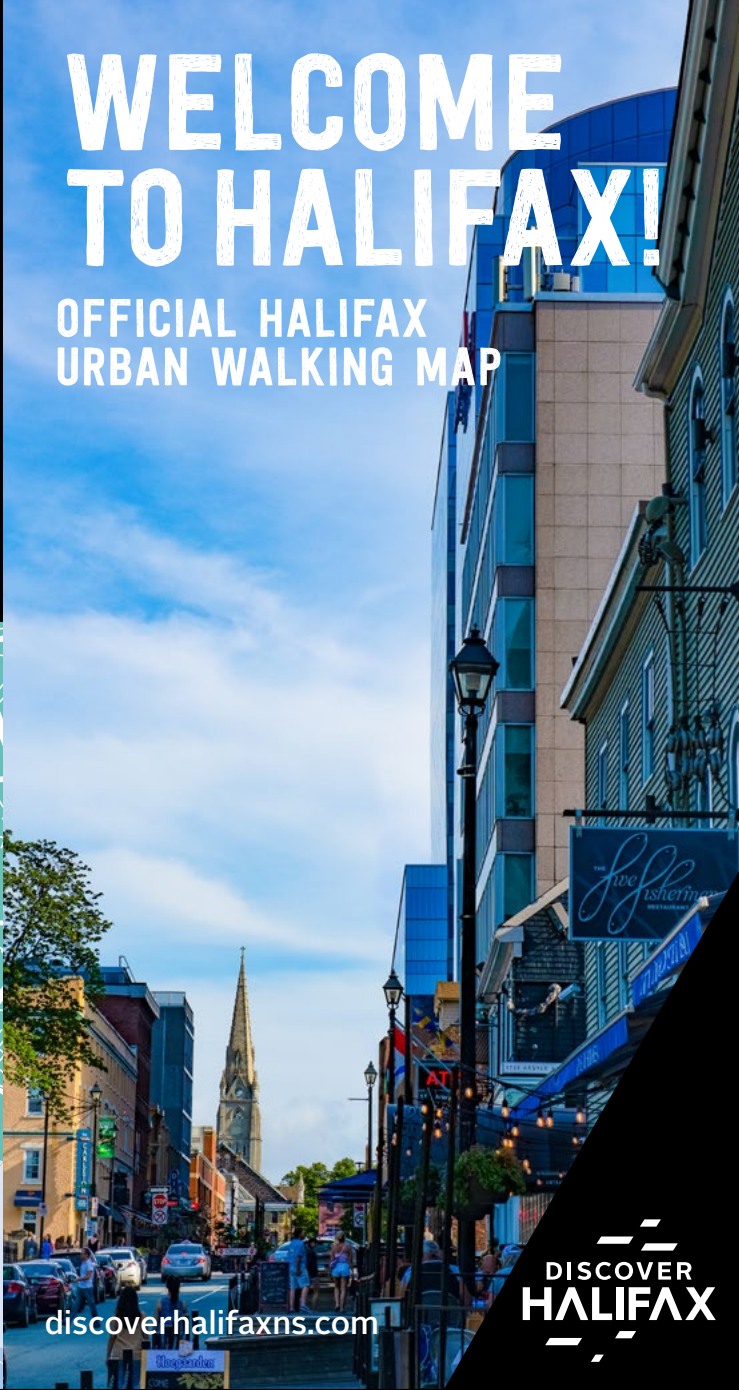
Cuisine

- FERRY** For just \$2.75 enjoy a 15-minute ferry ride across the Halifax Harbour, and explore both Downtown Halifax and Downtown Dartmouth!
- BUS** Halifax Transit offers reliable and affordable bus service, with routes throughout North End Halifax, Downtown Dartmouth and Downtown Halifax.

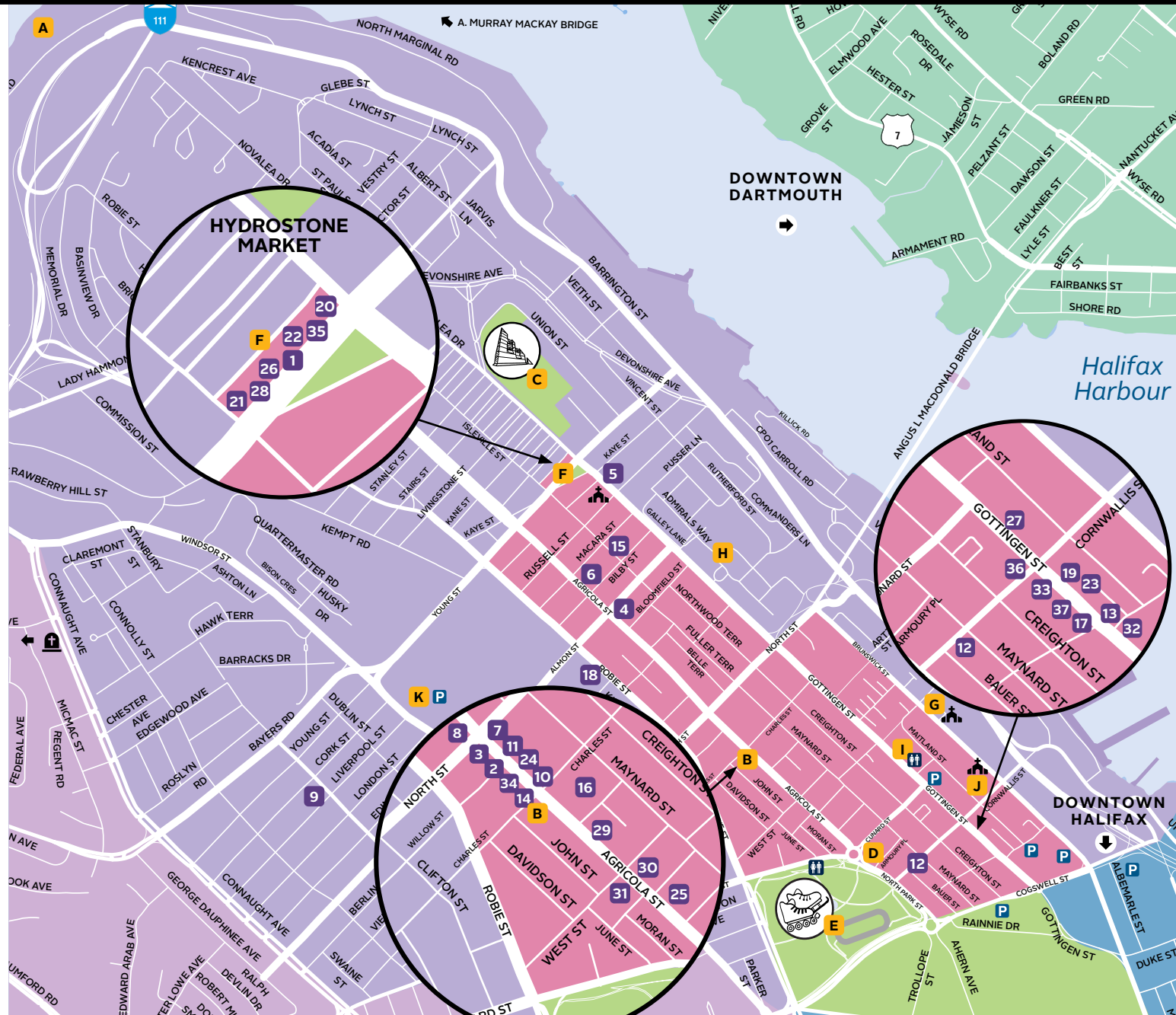
