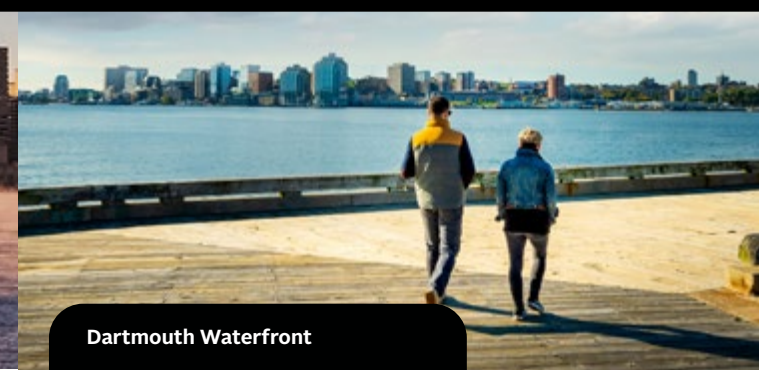


# DOWNTOWN DARTMOUTH
